We know that many schools are working hard to collect data right now, and other schools have completed their collection. If your school



### What's What for Study Participation

Participating in the GDO Study consists of full administration of the GDO and pilot items, as well as a Teacher Questionnaire and Parent/Guardian Questionnaire for each participating child. Eligible participants must be between 2.3 to 6.3\* years of age and speak English as their primary language. As a <u>thank you</u>, we provide all GDO study forms FREE to each participating school, and offer **\$10** per completed set of data (all 4 forms).

\*Please Note: Children must not be 6.3 + any days. Use <u>6.2 and 29</u> <u>days</u> as a better estimate to avoid ineligible data for the study.
