Wore Pilot Study Data Needed!

While many schools have been working hard to collect GDO data, we are still searching for some select sites to collect Pilot data. This data is important for focusing the course of Gesell Institute's Next Steps, preparing the Institute for the future, and moving our assessments forward. *If your school is interested in participating in this cutting edge research, please contact Ashley or Andrea* @ 203.777.3481 immediately!

Pilot data collection includes the pilot items, consisting of a 10 min child interview, and obtaining Teacher Questionnaire, and Parent/Guardian Questionnaire (each take approximately 5 minutes to complete). Unlike administering the full GDO, Pilot data collection is quick and can be completed during quiet moments in the classroom. Teachers do not have to be GDO trained in order to administer the Pilot items. Receive \$7.50 per completed set of forms!
