GDO National Study

WELCOME TO PROGRESS! Gesell Institute's national study is pursuing its most active phase of data collection. Schools across the nation collected data on the Gesell Developmental Observation (GDO). **Eleven new schools have joined just this month!** We are welcoming just a few schools to collect data in January and February '10 to top off our numbers so that each age band can have a minimum of 200 sets of data. Don't miss your last opportunity to take part in this important study!

What's What for Study Participation

Participating in the GDO Study consists of full administration of the GDO and pilot items, as well as a Teacher Questionnaire and Parent/Guardian Questionnaire for each

participating child. Eligible participants must be between 2.3 to 6.3* years of age and speak English as their primary language. As a <u>thank you</u>, we provide all GDO study forms FREE to each participating school, and remunerate schools **\$10 per completed set of data (4 forms).**

*Please Note: Children must not be 6.3 + any days. Use 6.2 and 29 days

as a better estimate to avoid ineligible data for the study.
